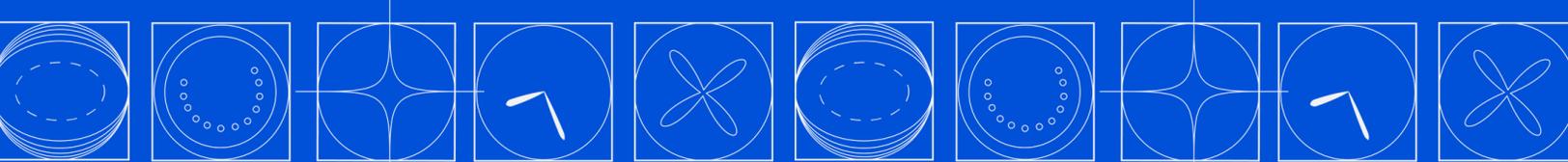

The selected ideas have the potential to generate new data on reverse supply chains, manufacturing supply chains, ecommerce, and freight movement; better leverage satellite imagery; increase real time monitoring capabilities; integrate climate and environmental data for supply chain insights, and more.

The eight winning teams will receive monetary prizes with a total value of \$350,000. Winners will also have an opportunity to advance to Phase 3, where they will be challenged to test their roadmaps and produce real data with an opportunity to pursue the adoption of their data, method, or technology by the U.S. Census Bureau.

We congratulate the winners of Phase 2 and thank them for their innovative work and dedication to transforming our nation's supply chain data. We also thank everyone who applied to the challenge for their passion, diligence, and ingenuity, and the many judges who volunteered their expertise to help select the winners.
